



One Mill provides funding for school programs and personnel in Alachua County, including:

-  Art/music/drama programs
-  Band/chorus
-  Career/tech programs & academic magnets
-  School counselors
-  Classroom technology
-  School librarians

The One Mill, first approved by voters in 2008 and renewed every four years since then, raises about \$23 million annually, helping fund the salaries of over 350 local teachers and supporting all 27,000+ Alachua County Public Schools (ACPS) students.

The renewal of the One Mill will be on the ballot this fall. Election Day is November 5.

In keeping with the ballot language, an independent citizens' oversight committee reviews all expenditures to ensure the revenues are spent as intended. The committee's financial documents and meeting minutes are available online.
